Application for Certificate of Registered Particulars by Immigration Department

1.Eligibility

Hong Kong ID card holder can apply for a Certificate of Registered Particulars showing the particulars registered in his/her identity card records, such as name, residential address, date of birth, place of birth, marital status and name of spouse.

2.How to Apply:

(1) Means of Application - Local

(I) In Person

Complete the application form ROP122 and submit it in person to any Registration of Persons Office (except Kwun Tong (Temporary) Office).

(II) Internet / Immigration Department Mobile Application.

(Applicant should register "iAM Smart+" account with digital signature function.) Application Website click <u>here.</u>

(III) If the applicant cannot apply in person due to poor health and cannot submit via the 2 means above, he/she can apply by post or authorize a representative to handle the application on his/her behalf.

(2) Means of Application - Outside Hong Kong

- (I) Internet / Immigration Department Mobile Application
- (II) By Post

3.Requirement Documents:

- (1) Application Form—ROP122(Download here)
- (2) A copy of Applicant's Hong Kong ID card or travel document.

The following documents may need to be used if applicable:

- (3) Health certificate (if unable to apply in person due to health reasons in Hong Kong)
- (4) Written Explanation of Application Reasons with signature and fingerprint (Apply by post or authorized application)
- (5) Notarized Document(if you apply by post from outside Hong Kong) For applicants applying by mail from outside Hong Kong, a notarization of the copy of the Hong Kong ID card or travel document, photo, and left or right thumbprint is required to verify the applicant's identity.
- (6) The representative's Hong Kong ID Card or valid travel document.
- (7) The power of attorney (for authorized applications)

Note: If you have never applied for a smart ID card (i.e., the issue date of your ID card is before June 22, 2003), you should provide a left thumbprint.
